

Who We Are

The Parviz Tanavoli Museum was established in Tehran, Iran to house the works of internationally acclaimed sculptor, collector and writer Parviz Tanavoli.

Aside from the many artworks created by the artist, there are various collections both in Iranian artifacts as well as modern art created by over 4 generations of Iranian artists are showcased in this area.

Parviz Tanavoli is very passionate about Iran, its people, culture, literature and heritage. Elements of Iranian forms and icons appear in his work numerous times. The Covid-19 Medals which were designed by the artist to help improve working conditions of the health workers in Iran have such same icons, namely the Nightingale on one side and the Cypress Tree on the other side. The charity medals sold out worldwide within days, helping the Parviz Tanavoli Museum raise upwards of \$90,000 US, which was spent as followed in this report.



PROJECTS



Taleghani Hospital-Tehran

A Covid-19 center in Tehran with 31 years of medical practice is one of the medical educational, and treatment centers affiliated to Shahid Beheshti University of Medical Sciences.

The hospital academic staff who are 86 specialists provide services in 6 post specialties including vascular surgery, endocrine, digestion, nephrology, hematology & medical oncology, and bone marrow transplantation, which is unique in the university, and 10 other specialties. The Taleghani Hospital was the recipient of a bone marrow drill, as well as a liquid oxygen tank with the help of Nikan Mammut Chairy.



Imam Khomeyni Hospital-Divan Darreh, Kurdestan

A covid-19 center for the western province of Kurdistan, this hospital has been catering to the medical needs of that region for the last 25 years. With various wards, this hospital was – and still is at the time of preparing this report- one of the most effected covid-19 districts. This hospital received two BiPAP machines.



Fayyaz Bakhsh Hospital-Tehran

One of the largest centers for Covid-19 pandemic in Iran, they are also a research hospital on the matter. Their staff and healthworkers hard work was essential to controlling the spread of covid-19 further.

FBH received four BIPAP machines, gift cards for staff who worked 24 hour shifts without extra pay, and a donated medal to the entire staff from Canadian donor, Dr. Anthony Phillips.



Ganjavian Hospital-Dezfoul, Ahwaz

A central covid-19 hospital in southern province of Ahwaz in Iran, the Ganjavian Hospital was built by donations in 1997. With 352 beds, the hospital caters to all major divisions including CCU, ENT, ICU, urology, neurology, OBGYN, psychology, oncology, NICU1, NICU2, POST CCU, orthopedic, nursery etc.

Ganjavian Hospital received its first ventilator from the PTM charity funds.



Imam Ali Hospital-Andimeshk, Khuzestan

Located in one of the affiliated hospitals to the University of Jondishapour Medical Sciences. 133 beds and various wards complete this hospital which was built in 1956. This hospital catered to the Iran/Iraq war, providing assistance to injured before transfer to other cities.

IAH received two BiPAP machines.



Razi Hospital-Ahwaz, Khuzestan

Razi Hospital was established in 1945 by the National Railroad company. Later it was transferred to the University of Medical Sciences in Khuzestan, where it continued work in various wards, with a concentration on infectious disease.

This hospital received a rare machine named HFNC, complete with its spare parts.



Shariat Razavi Hospital-Tehran

Located in one of the most impoverished area of Tehran, the SRH has been a center for covid-19 since the beginning of the pandemic. This social services hospital has a large number of patients, due to its acceptance of social security insurance.

SRH received a ventilator for its ICU unit.



Barakat Charity Foundation

The BCF was established in Tehran by reknowned filmmaker Rakhshan Bani-Etemad, to provide jobs to indigent women, while helping out with various social and structural issues in Iran.

For covid-19 pandemic, PTM ordered and purchased over 5000 set of masks, gowns, and isolation sterile outfits, made and delivered to Dezfoul, Yasouj, Aqajari and Khoramshahr.



Mehrgity Charity Foundation

A non-profit organization which works towards education of the poorest areas of Iran through classes and cultural trainings. This charity focuses on children, schools and institutions that are in need of help during any emergency.

PTM provided food stamps for health workers at the Rasoul Hospital, a center for covid-19 at a poverty stricken area.

EQUIPMENT DONATED



Ventilator

A ventilator is a machine that provides mechanical ventilation by moving breathable air in and out of the lungs, to deliver breath to patients that cannot breath on their own.



BIPAP (Bilevel Positive Airway Pressure)

Similar to a CPAP machine, a BIPAP machine is a non-invasive form of therapy for patients suffering from sleep apnea. The machine delivers pressurized air through a mask to keep the patients airways open.



Orthopedic surgical drills

Orthopedic surgical drills is one of the most common devices which used in most orthopedic surgery such as all of othopedic fractures, arthroplasty, artroscopy and also treating tendon ruptures such as rotator cuff. So, drill is one of our critical and most useful surgical devices which we can say without this device orthopedic surgery cannot be done.



High Flow Nasal Cannula Machine (HFNC)

HFNC therapy is an oxygen supply system capable of delivering up to 100% humidified and heated oxygen at the flow rate of up to 60 liters per minute.



Central Liquid Oxygen Supply System

Hospitals supply oxygen to beds and surgery units through high pressured cylinders.
